Our 2002 Seven Sinners "*Incahoots*" bottling showcases the ripe and expressive Syrah of District 8 - Paso Robles. Harvested from ultra rich hillside fruit near Creston (southeast of Templeton) the wine exhibits deep raspberry and blackberry jam flavors combined with exotic spices and leather. The ripe tannins and lush integrated oak carry through the rich finish.
